1. Background

The Ministry of Communications and Information Technology (MCIT), Islamic Republic of Afghanistan has received Project Grant from the World Bank for implementation of Digital CASA Afghanistan Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds to hire a qualified Consultancy Firm to carry out Technical Feasibility Study for the Enhancement of Government Cloud and Disaster Recovery Data Center.

The aim of the Digital CASA Afghanistan Project is: (i) to Strengthen the Regional and Expand National level broadband connectivity based on Optical Fiber Networks; (ii) to boost up digital society and economy through e-Governance initiatives and (iii) to prepare an enabling environment and Regulations for the growth of ICT Sector in Afghanistan. The project will do so by: (a) expansion and strengthening of broadband connectivity in Central Asia and South Asia Regions; (b) expansion and strengthening of national broadband connectivity in Afghanistan; (c) Commissioning of a Network called "GovNet" to connect most of the Government Offices at Central and Provincial Government levels in Afghanistan; (d) Automation of citizen-centric services through e-Governance initiatives of Islamic Republic of Afghanistan; (e) Automation of

e-Governance mechanisms and strengthening of e-Delivery Platforms in Afghanistan; (f) framing up of Regulations, Policies, Strategies and Procedures for growth of ICT Sector of Afghanistan.

2. Objectives of the assignment

On Government/Commercial Cloud

The Firm will carry out two reviews, the first review would be on Afghanistan's National Data Center and the second review would be on Commercial Cloud Service Offerings. The intent of the two reviews is to assess the optimal approach to introducing "Cloud Computing" services to the Line Ministries and other major Government Organizations.

Under the first review, an in-depth analysis will be conducted on the systems, networking elements, hardware, software along with licenses as installed in Afghanistan National Data Center (ANDC) at MCIT's main building, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) as per international standards such as ITIL, legal and regulatory framework to ascertain the viability of Augmentation / enhancement of the ANDC into a Disaster Recovery Data Centre (DRDC) and Government Cloud.

The Firm will be required to suggest measures to implement "Cloud Computing", with the aim to mainstream the services to Line Ministries and other major Government Organizations. The intent is to reduce costs and time taken for commissioning of ICT infrastructure by separate line Ministries and government agencies for their ICT systems and new digital services.

Under the second review, the Firm will also be required to review Commercial Cloud Service Offerings (including international best practices) as an alternative option to introduce "Cloud Computing". The commercial cloud service offerings could be based in Afghanistan or elsewhere. The Firm shall assess if the commercial cloud service providers are able to fulfill the functional, technical and security requirements set out by the Government of Afghanistan.

Based on the in-depth analysis of the first review i.e. ANDC and the second review i.e. Commercial Cloud Service Offerings, the Firm shall evaluate and recommend the optimal pragmatic approach for the Government of Afghanistan to establish/enhance the Government/Commercial Cloud.

The Firm shall identify a set of Common Digital Service Enablers that are essential for digital service implementations. The essence of a Common Digital Service Enabler is to facilitate and accelerate the digital service implementations. The Common Digital Service Enablers are required by multiple line ministries for digital service implementation and would be more efficiently provisioned as a common service for the ministries to utilize.

The Firm shall identify a suite of suitable migration services to the Government Cloud.

On Disaster Recovery Data Center (DRDC)

The Firm will suggest options to establish/enhance a Disaster Recovery Data Center (DRDC). These may include a full-fledged backup National Level Data Center located either in Afghanistan or elsewhere in the region.

For both Government/Commercial Cloud and DRDC

Both Government/Commercial Cloud and DRDC will be developed by leveraging a variety of PPP approaches between local data center companies, international data center companies and respective governments in the region or through a commercial cloud service provider.

Various options of Government/Commercial cloud and DRDC along with the pros and cons will be presented in the report to the government; government will select the option for implementation in Afghanistan. For the selected option, prepare the relevant documents including Technical Specifications and Bill of Quantities (BOQ) required for preparation of bidding document/s for Government/Commercial Cloud and DRDC.

1. Scope of Services

Task 1:

- A. Submission of inception report. The firm shall develop in inception report consisting of the following components:
 - i. Detailed implementation methodology
 - ii. Work Plan (Project Implementation Plan)
 - iii. Project Governance Structure
- B. A workshop session/s to increase awareness of different clouds options for different levels of leadership and technical staff should be arranged in Kabul.

Task 2: Evaluate options for Government/Commercial Cloud including DRDC.

On Government/Commercial Cloud

- The consultancy firm will do assessment of existing Afghanistan National Data Center (ANDC) including Disaster Recovery Data Center (DRDC) and local data centers in some ministries including cyber security provisions.
- Based on their assessment the firm will evaluate the possibility of usage of existing data center facilities in various options being suggested for government/commercial cloud and the approach to enhance cyber security provisions.
- The consultancy firm shall study International best practices for usage of Government/Commercial Cloud specifically for public service delivery and Government applications. Consultant shall analyze suitability of appropriate practices with the perspective of scenarios in Afghanistan.
- Out of the International best practices studied above; the consulting firm shall review in details at least 3 international Government/Commercial Cloud services which may be relevant to Afghanistan.
- The consultancy firm should propose various options for example: government cloud, commercial cloud and/or hybrid approach taking into account legal and regulatory framework in Afghanistan, based on above assessment and evaluation of existing facilities and on the basis of selected international practices.

- The Firm shall assess if the Government/Commercial cloud service providers are able to fulfill the legal and regulatory framework along with technical and security requirements that are being set by the Government of Afghanistan. Incase these requirements are not available at the time of finalization of TOR, the consultant shall help MCIT in setting up of technical and security requirements as per international best practices.
- The consultancy firm should identify a set of Common Digital Service Enablers e.g. online authentication/ digital signature, notification alerts, e-payments that are essential for digital service implementations and include them in the bid document.
- The consultant shall, in discussion with Government stakeholders, identify a suite of suitable and prioritized services for migration to the Government/Commercial Cloud.
- The consultant will engage with the government to assess the demand for government/commercial cloud services over short, medium and long term requirements.
- Based on the in-depth analysis of the ANDC and commercial cloud service offerings, the consultancy firm to recommend the most optimal approach for the Government of Afghanistan to establish/enhance the Government/Commercial Cloud.

On Disaster Recovery Data Center (DRDC)

- The consultant shall assess the needs for (1) Disaster Recovery Data Center and (2) business continuity of government arrangements and provide respective recommendations.
- The consultant shall propose thorough recommendations and approaches to establish/enhance the DRDC.

For Both Government/Commercial Cloud and DRDC

 Various options of Government/Commercial cloud and DRDC along with the pros and cons will be presented in the report to the government. Both Government/Commercial Cloud and DRDC will be developed by leveraging a variety of PPP approaches between local data center companies, international data center companies and national or regional governments. Government will select the option for implementation in Afghanistan.

4. Qualification Requirements/Short listing Criteria:

The short listing criteria are:

- a) The Consultancy Firm should be registered as a legal entity in the relevant field and should be in existence for at least last 5 years.
- **b)** The Consultancy firm to demonstrate having a sound financial capacity of annual turnover at least USD 600,000 in any one of the last 3 years. The firm is required to submit audited financial reports or any other credible financial documents as a proof.
- c) The consultant shall provide proven experience of having executed at least one contract of similar nature and complexity during last 5 years with the total value of USD 500,000. The consultants are required to provide copy (ies) of the contract along with clients' certificate towards completion of such assignments with their EOI. The Consultant while describing the assignment(s) for similar experience should furnish the following details:
 - Consultant should explain in what way the executed assignment(s) was/were similar in nature to the current assignment.
 - The Consultant should explain the exact role played by the Consultant in the assignment if the assignment was carried out in association with other firms as JV or in sub-consultancy for carrying out the assignment.
- **d)** The requirements for Consultants who intends to associate with other firm(s) in the form of a Joint Venture (JV) or sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications are indicated as under:

 - **b)** JV Partner: Shall meet at least 25% of the shortlisting criteria for annual turnover requirement defined under Part 4 above (Qualification Requirements/Short listing Criteria), paragraphs (b).
 - c) When fulfilling the above minimum requirements, in aggregate, the lead member and JV partner(s) shall meet at least 100% of the short listing criteria referred to above. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.
 - II. The short listing criteria provided under Part 4 above (Qualification Requirements/Short listing Criteria), paragraphs (b) and (c) will not be applied for sub-consultant.
- e) The Consultant should furnish only true and factual information in the EOI (for itself, its partners and sub-consultant(s), if any). By an act of submission of an EOI against this REoI, the Consultant shall be deemed to be aware that for any misrepresentation by the Consultant

in regards to its EOI including any qualification documents/information about the consultant itself, its partner and/or sub-consultant detected at any stage of selection process or during execution of the resultant contract, if successful, the Consultant will be prosecuted under the Laws of Afghanistan.
